The link will be provided to the Planner on file, the Ward Councilor and the Corktown Neighborhood Association. The microsite will provide a portal for members of the public to access the submitted reports, studies and supporting information that has been provided to the City. Updates on the project will also be posted on the site, as they occur. • Our office will attend and be prepared to provide a presentation at the statutory public meeting, at Planning Committee.
